

### The Sportina 680

Designed by Andrzej Skrzat (1991)

With an LOA of 6.8m, the Sportina 680 was the first racing yacht designed by the company tobereviewedbythePolishsailingpress. It was also the first to be presented to the global press overseas at an international fair. The Sportina 680 competed in many European challenges.

### The Sportlake 730

Designed by Jacek Centkowski (1993)

A further development of the 660, the Sportlake 730 was a scaled up version which later became the Delphia 24.

### The Sportina 600

esigned by Andrzej Skrzat (1996)

Designed in 1996 with an LOA of 6m, the Sportina 600 was based on the design style of Andrzej Skrzat. It was designed to meet the needs of the intermediate sailor and, with a unique ballasting system, proved exceptionally stable. There were two versions available - a cruiser and mid-line racer. Boasting a full galley and four berths, it proved its credentials as a serious contender for long trips or distance racing.

### The Sportina 682

Designed by Andrzej Skrzat (1993)

The Sportina 682 was launched asthesmallersistertotheSportina760. The design basis was similar to that of the 760, but had berthing for five crew.

### The Aero 24 Sportlake

Designed by Andrzej Skrzat (1991)

favoured designer, the Aero 24 Sportlake with an LOA of 7.3m was aimed directly at the racing fraternity. With this in mind, it was designed to be an open class racing yacht. The accommodation fulfilled the basic requirements with a small, yet functional galley and berthing for three.

### The Sportina 760

esigned by Andrzej Skrzat (1998)

The Sportina 760 burst onto the market in 1998. With an LOA of 7.6m, full galley, toilet and six berths, it was directed firmly at the cruising and family markets. Proving excellent handling capabilities and available in either swing or fixed keel versions meant it was perfect for inland and offshore cruising.

Launched in mid 1999, the Sportlake 505 also had the option of either a fixed or swing keel. It excelled when sailing close to the wind and had a maximum draught of 24 cm making it ideal for shallow water racing.

### The Sportlake 660



Introduced in 2001, Delphia commissioned a design from Andrzej Skrzat to create a blue water cruiser in two versions; ballast and ballast keel for shallow and deep water cruising. This classic design was the forerunner of later Delphia yachts.


The design process is one of the most critical stages in the pursuit of excellence. All of Delphia's yachts designed by Andrzej Skrzat, renowned naval architect of 40 years. Our construction team takes Andrzej Skrzat's design and transfers it into the Catia 3D CAD program, the latest fully-integrated CAD software, to prepare a program for the CNC machine. All the details of the yacht - from the shape and structure of the hull to the deck and sail plan arrangement

 are designed to achieve the best possible sailing characteristics. Thanks to advanced computer design, it is possible to check even the smallest details in terms of ergonomics, collision points and structural integrity.

Every feature is part of a 'total design concept', which is carefully amalgamated into the yacht taking into account weight distribution, functionality and ease of access to the vessel.

Delphia Yachts cooperates closely with Schnaase Interior Design. The sumptuous interiors are designed for maximum comfort at sea with uncompromised styling creating a luxurious atmosphere. Every aspect of construction reflects the highest standards of craftsmanship, from moulding the hulls, installation of the engineering and electrical systems, to the interior finishing. With over 20 years of experience in the boat building industry, Delphia Yachts has become respected for enviable build quality together with incorporating superior marine technology.

Delphia Yachts has extensive experience in utilising precision CNC machining in its construction processes allowing rapid

and exact sculpting of a variety of materials thus ensuring perfect symmetry of each vessel.

Our construction department cooperates closely with research institutes and technical colleges, including The Marine Technology Centre, C.T.O.(Ship Design and Research Centre, Gdańsk), Gdańsk University of Technology, The Department of Ocean Engineering for Maritime Ships, Warsaw University of Technology and The Department of Mechanical Engineering, Energy and Aviation. Delphia also manufactures designs for other boatyards.



22 Construction

The laminating department at Delphia Yachts boatyard consists of two sections: sailing yachts and motor boats - which together occupy in excess of seven thousand square meteres. The halls are equipped with gantry cranes, air regulation, atmospheric climate control, pneumatic installations, resin application and hypobaric installations. All these integrated systems allow for safe and easy handling of the yachts as well as provide the climate required for the production of composite sections.

Within this department, the basic hull and deck structures are formed. Glass reinforced plastic laminates are formed from materials with different mechanical properties in which the reinforcing component (woven glass) is laid in the form of opposing layers (laying-up). This method ensures the hull and decks are durable while retaining rigidity and integrity as well as eliminating the need for painting (different coloured resins determine the final colour, though there remains the need for anti-fouling coating if the vessel is left in the water for prolonged periods).






The composite components (decks, hulls etc.) are formed by utilising the latest infusion technology. Infusion is a process during which a vacuum is achieved in the area between the mould and vacuum bag. This difference in pressure draws the resin through the woven glass mats and ensures total impregnation. The infusion system has several advantages over the more typical brushed and sprayed lay-up methods. Styrene emissions are minimal, the end product is stronger, lamination is completely formed and the manufacturing time is greatly reduced. Laminates made by using the infusion

system demonstrate much higher strengths compared to other methods.

Within the laminating department are a team of engineers who are responsible for the strength of the constructions and to ensure compliance with all technical regulations and build detail. These engineers also calculate the mechanical and mass balance figures of the yachts to achieve a safe and uncompromising vessel.






All the furniture aboard our yachts is manufactured within our factory. The joinery shop is equipped with a CNC cutting machine which encompasses speed, consistency and quality throughout the production run, time and time again.

During the design phase of each project, 3D computer models of the furniture are created using our CAD system "Catia 3D". This crucial process ensures that we have accurately modelled the styling, ergonomics and functionality of the furniture.

All the wooden fittings of the interior are made from the highest quality, oak, beech, cherry and mahogany as standard. However, should our client request a different wood finish to the standard offering, this can of course be achieved.








26 Joinery

The assembly department at Delphia Yachts boatyard comprises two sections - sailing yachts and motor boats. These departments cover over 10,000 square meters with halls equipped with gantry cranes, pneumatic installations, a hypobaric vacuum system with gas heating in a climate-controlled environment. One hall is also equipped with a tank and drenching system for water-proofing tests. This is the place where all the manufactured elements are finally put together, creating an excellent yacht.


Our employees using specialized machinery, ensure

that assembly of each boat runs smoothly. Developed assembly technology allows rapid high quality construction. Production in the hall is divided into stands with each hall divided into zones. The boat is assembled in the first area and the hull of the yacht is outfitted with installations and furniture in the second. The last process in this area involves covering the hull with a deck. The third zone deals with the final installation of the deck fittings. The tank in the fourth zone allows tightness testing of the yacht prior to electrical and motor installations. The last stage in this area is final inspection and approval of the yacht performed by quality control.
























Delphia Yachts proudly holds ISO 9001:2000. To obtain this certification, the boatyard must be able to demonstrate that all the required systems for traceability, staff training and defect reporting (to name just three) are in place and have quality control personnel in each department throughout every stage of production. Every stage, from the initial design through the final sale of a boat, is tightly controlled and recorded by quality control who are responsible for detecting any defects early on and ensuring they are not only rectified, but reported and investigated so as to better understand any failings and to prevent any possible future reoccurrence.

Our experienced quality team monitors and ensures that properly documented working practices are uniformly employed throughout the construction on all our yachts.


These standards, which start in our design studio are under constant review in pursuit of improved quality and superior engineering.

Delphia's engineers, team leaders and management hold regular meetings to appraise build methods, working practices and specifications. Our boatyard is working with a renowned research institute, The Marine Technology Centre in Gdańsk. Before implementation of the prototype project, the shape of the hull, design of the rudders and the ballasting systems are tested in the model tank and consist of wave and resistance testing at different angles of roll and pitch. Every detail is included in the reporting system for the quality control department.

The classification of our yachts is recorded by The Polish Register of Shipping (PRS) and Germanischer Lloyd GL.















At Delphia Yachts, we strive to provide an unsurpassed level of after sales service. Our after sales team has access to our archive containing the build records for each and every Delphia yacht so, should an owner need help whilst half way across the ocean, no time is wasted in establishing which parts are required to fix the boat and solve the problem.
